

DRIVER/MATERIAL HANDLER – Wayne County Recycling Center

Scope of Services Description

Position Summary

Driver/Material Handler must have experience and be proficient with the operation of large trucks. The position requires a good knowledge of mechanics and the ability to troubleshoot basic mechanical problems, which may arise. The position requires a willingness and ability to learn how to operate different pieces of equipment that will be used at the Recycling Center such as; horizontal baler, vertical baler, can crusher, can blower, skid-steer loader, etc. Because of the nature of the equipment used at the Center, the Driver/Material Handler must be a safety-oriented worker and one who pays close attention to detail. Since contact with the general public will be a daily occurrence, the position requires someone who is polite and courteous. A basic familiarity of Wayne County as well as a willingness to learn is essential. Due to the nature of the job and the solid waste and recycling field in general, the Driver/Material Handler will need to be able to adjust and compensate for changes in scheduling, which may occur occasionally. Some Saturday work will be required.

Essential Job Functions:

- Deliver and retrieve roll-off containers throughout Wayne County with the County's roll-off trucks.
- Assist the general public as well as municipalities by answering basic recycling questions.
- Accept recyclables delivered to the Recycling Center. (This includes screening of incoming materials to insure quality).
- Separate and process various recyclable materials.
- Perform basic mechanical repairs to equipment used at the Center.
- Daily cleanup of Recycling Center.
- Open and close Recycling Center during startup and shutdown.
- Follow county staff and personnel policy guidelines.
- Submit to federally required CDL drug and alcohol testing requirements.
- This position requires heavy physical activity.

Qualifications

- Valid Pennsylvania CDL (Commercial Driver's License).
- Physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.
- Experience driving large trucks (over 26,000 lbs. GVW).

Pre-employment criminal history and driving background investigation is required.

Salary is \$24,708.97, based on (40) hour work week.
