INVITATION TO BID

The Wayne County Commissioners will receive sealed bids on a single prime contract project until 4:00 PM prevailing time on Wednesday, September 3rd, 2014 at the office of the Commissioners on the Third Floor of the Court House Annex at 925 Court Street, Honesdale, PA 18431. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud during the regular meeting of the Commissioners that begins at 10:30 AM on Thursday, September 4th 2014.

Bid packages including drawings and specifications may be obtained at the above address or by contacting the Commissioners Office at (570)253-5970 extension 4050. A \$10.00 non-refundable fee is required for the bid packages. Checks or money orders are to be payable to the Wayne County Commissioners.

Bids are invited on the following:

The removal and/or relocation of Approximately 192ft of chain link fence, the construction of a 5260 square feet of gravel parking area with access drive, the construction of one basketball court including relocation of existing supports rims and backboards from the existing court. The project includes an alternate which involves converting the existing basketball court into a parking area. The alternate includes the removal of approximately 360 ft of chain link fence, the relocation of the existing electrical service and the construction of approximately 140 ft of pressure treated guide rail. The relocation of the electrical service involves the installation of junction box or boxes where the existing services exists, the construction of a new support back board, the installation of a new meter base the installation of a new 200 amp electrical panel with overload protection for the exterior lighting and new photo cell sensor controls including relays to operate the existing lighting. Also included in the alternate is the replacement of approximately 70 ft of underground conduit and lighting power wiring between two existing pole lights.

The Commissioners reserve the right to reject any or all bids or waive any informalities in the Bidding. Bids may be held by the Commissioners for a period not to exceed 45 days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the qualifications of the Bidder, prior to the award of the Contract. The Contract will be awarded to the lowest Responsible bidder.
