

Uniformed Military and Overseas Voter Act (UMOVA)
and Federal Write-in Absentee Ballot (FWAB)

Wayne County, Pennsylvania Board of Elections

The Wayne County Board of Elections, pursuant to the provisions of P.L. 1333, known as “The Pennsylvania Election Code”, hereby gives NOTICE that elections are to be made for the following public offices in Wayne County at the November 4, 2014 General Election:

Public Office

Governor and Lieutenant Governor	(Vote for the Candidates of One Party)
Representative in Congress (10 th District)	(One)
Senator in the General Assembly (20 th District)	(One)
Representative in the General Assembly	111 th District (One) 139 th District (One)

Who is covered under UMOVA?

Covered voters include all of the following;

1. A uniformed-service voter who is registered to vote in the Commonwealth, which includes a veteran who is bedridden or hospitalized due to illness or physical disability.
2. An overseas voter who is registered to vote in the Commonwealth.
3. A uniformed-service voter who is not registered to vote in the Commonwealth but who otherwise satisfies the voter eligibility requirement of this Commonwealth: and
4. An overseas voter who is not registered to vote in the Commonwealth but who otherwise satisfies the voter eligibility requirements of this Commonwealth.

How do you apply for a military-overseas ballot?

1. Covered voters who are registered to vote in the Commonwealth may apply for a military-overseas ballot using either an absentee ballot application or the Federal Post Card Application (FPCA).
2. Covered voters who are not registered to vote in the Commonwealth may use a FPCA to both register to vote and apply for a military-overseas ballot simultaneously.
3. A uniformed-service voter may use the FWAB to apply for a military-overseas ballot and vote at the same time.

Instructions

- You may request an absentee ballot from this office at any time prior to a primary or election. However, if time does not permit you to receive and return an official absentee ballot, you are also entitled to vote using the FWAB.
- You may use FWAB to vote for a candidate for U.S. Representative in Congress, as well as candidates for all state and local offices, and ballot initiatives.

- To vote, refer to page 3 of the FWAB.
 1. To vote for U.S. Representative in Congress-write in the name of the candidate in the space provided on the FWAB.
 2. To vote for state and local offices or for ballot initiatives-write the names of candidates or the ballot initiative in the Addendum Section of the FWAB.
 3. Under the **Office/Ballot Initiative** heading, enter the office the candidate is running for or the title of the Ballot Initiative (referendum).
 4. Under the **Candidate Name, Party Affiliation or Initiative Vote** heading, list the name of the candidate you wish to vote for, or if you are voting on a referendum questions write "yes" or "no".

Representative in the General Assembly, 111th District in Wayne County: Bethany Borough, Buckingham Township, Canaan Township, Clinton Township # 1 and # 2, Dyberry Township, Honesdale Borough # 1, # 2 and # 3, Lake Township, Lebanon Township, Manchester Township, Mount Pleasant Township, Preston Township, Prompton Borough, Scott Township, South Canaan Township, Starrucca Borough, Texas Township # 1, # 2 and # 3, Waymart Borough.

Representative in the General Assembly, 139th District in Wayne County: Berlin Township # 1 and # 2, Cherry Ridge Township, Damascus Township # 1 and # 2, Dreher Township, Hawley Borough, Lehigh Township, Oregon Township, Palmyra Township, Paupack Township, Salem Township, Sterling Township.

The following is the unofficial list of candidates for the November 4, 2014 General Election as of August 5, 2014. Minor Party and Political Body candidates have until August 8, 2014 to withdraw their nomination papers; and Major Party candidates nominated at the May 20, 2014 Primary have until August 11, 2014 to withdraw.
