- If you make a mistake, do not erase. Ask for a new ballot.
- Use black or blue pen or pencil.
- Do not fold the ballot.

You may vote a Straight Party Ballot for the party of your choice by darkening the oval to the left of the party of your choice  
OR  
you may Split your ballot by darkening the oval to the left of the party of your choice and voting for individual candidates in any other party.
