D&H Rail Trail - 38 miles long from Simpson to the New York border near Susquehanna, PA. Ten miles have been improved with a stone dust surface suitable for hybrid and mountain bikes. The improved section runs along the Upper Lackawanna River from Vandling to Herrick Center. It is also used by equestrians, runners and hikers. Lacawac Sanctuary -- a nature center, environmental education center and biological field station located on 550 acres just on the Shore of Lake Wallenpaupack. It includes eight miles of hiking trails, the 52-acre glacial Lake Lacawac and an Adirondack-style great camp.

State Game Lands – Wayne County is home to five State Game Lands, managed by the PA Game Commission. They include 159 mostly in Lebanon Township, includes a public shooting range; 299 in Scott Township; 300 partially in South Canaan Township; 310 in Lake Township; and 312 partially in Dreher Township.
