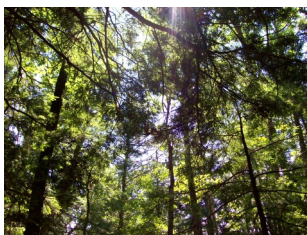

 - operations

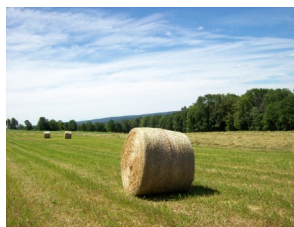

 - Assistance with waterways and encroachment permits

Nutrient Management Services:

- Help farmers properly utilize their manure and fertilizers for maximum crop needs while adhering to Pennsylvania's Act 38 Nutrient Management Regulations
- Assisting with nutrient management plan development, implementation and grant assistance
- Assisting with manure spreader calibration, soil testing and soil health issues
- Provides a No-Till Seeder for rent and assisting with planting of fields
 - Promotion of runoff solutions to maintain clean waterways, streams and ponds
- Promotion of erosion control methods with vegetative buffers, no-till methods, best management practices and grass-based farming
