 - b) Motion to hire Lauren Sandercock as a Aging Care Manager 2 in the Area Agency on Aging, effective January 10, 2022, for a 37.5-hour work week. Set her salary at \$17.23 per hour, or \$33,727.72 annually, a 35 B on the approved compensation scale.
 - c) Motion to hire Akyra Olsen as a part-time corrections officer at the Wayne County Correction Facility, effective Jan. 10, 2022.
 - d) Motion to increase the salary of April Clark, Aging Case Aide 2, at the Area Agency of Aging, to \$14.59 for attaining a certification, in accordance with the County Human Services' Compensation Plan.
 - e) Motion to approve salary increases to \$13.35 an hour for part time transportation drivers Gerard Beskovoyne and Roger Myers, effective Jan. 10, 2022, for reaching five years with the county.
 - f) Motion to approve a salary increase to \$15.24 an hour for part time transportation driver Stephen Haber, effective Jan. 10, 2022, for reaching 10 years with the county.
