Clinton Township Board of Supervisors Meeting

An emergency meeting of the Clinton Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Chairman James Zefran on Friday, November 23, 2020 at 7:00 PM at the Clinton Township municipal building. Chairman James Zefran, Vice Chair Brian Non, and Supervisor Russel Curtis were in attendance. Solicitor Jeffrey Treat was also in attendance.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the Burns Road job with Gary Linde who was also in attendance. The issue of the \$42,000.00 being held in escrow for the purpose of repairing the damaged area on Burns Road was the focus of the meeting, along with the awarded bid of \$71,700.00 to pave the overlay. Mr. Linde said that they could proceed if weather allows. He stated that all he had to go by is measurements and that they would need the road marked by a week from this Wednesday. Additionally, he noted that his company makes hot patch all winter. He asked about the pipe crossing at Grimms and was told that it needs to be dug out. Solicitor Treat said that he had received a check from Ken Coles, made out to Linde, in the amount of \$42,000.00. Treat stated that the original contract with Frank Rodriguez & Flagge stated that the base repair work on Burns Road had to be done by December 30, 2020. The check is being held by Treat. Chair Zefran made a motion, seconded by Vice Chair Non to have E. R. Linde repair the damaged area on Burns Road starting after the Thanksgiving holiday of 2020 for the escrowed amount. All voted yes. The motion carried.
