

January 11, 2019
Clinton Township Board of Supervisors Meeting

A special January meeting of the Clinton Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Vice Chair Non on January 11, 2019 at 7:02 PM at the Clinton Township municipal building for the purpose of opening bids for the Browndale Sidewalk. Vice Chair Brian Non was present and Chairman Kenneth Coles was present by phone.

A. Pledge of Allegiance

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

B. Opening of Bids – Bids were opened from the following companies:

Malocco Excavating, Inc. - \$483,000.00

Kohrs Excavating - \$481,800.00

Pioneer Construction Co., Inc. - \$892,189.00

Leeward Construction, Inc. - \$424,424.00

Linda Zefran, the head of this grant project, was asked how much can be spent on this project. She said that the grants total roughly \$393,000 less what has already been spent on engineering fees leaves approximately \$374,000. She expressed that she wants the engineers that have been working on the project (Kiley Associates) to look over the bids and not award the bid until they are analyzed by Joe Hudak. She noted that originally the sidewalk was to go all the way to Forest City, to Turkey Hill. Now it will run only to Railroad Street. Chair Coles asked how the township can accept a bid for greater than the amount that is available to spend? Ms. Zefran said she wasn't sure. Chair Coles continued by asking if the township was responsible to make up the monetary difference to which Ms. Zefran stated "Absolutely not." She went on to explain that the project must be completed by June 30, 2019. She is hoping, worst case scenario, to award the bid at the February meeting and to physically start the job in March. Chair Coles asked if they would have to rebid to modify the bid specifications to say how far the sidewalk is going. Linda Zefran relayed that Joe Hudak of Kiley Associates did not think so. She stated that she believed that it would be possible to break down the bids into a lineal foot bid and that the bid could be awarded in February without rebidding.

C. Adjournment – Vice Chair Non made a motion, seconded by Chair Coles to adjourn the meeting at 7:10 p.m. All voted yes. The motion carried.
