Clinton Township Board of Supervisors Meeting

A special meeting of the Clinton Township Board of Supervisors was called to order by Supervisor Russell Curtis on April 16, 2019 at 7:00 PM at the Clinton Township municipal building for the purpose of opening bids for paving Ravnika and Smith roads. Chair Ken Coles and Vice Chair Brian Non were present by phone.

**A. Pledge of Allegiance**

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

**B. Open Issues**

- a. **Paving Bids** – Supervisor Curtis opened the only bid envelope, coming from Wayco Incorporated. He reported the results as follows:

When asked the particulars, Supervisor Curtis said it included 2' shoulders and 19 mm base, with a 2.5" sweep, but that it had no crossovers. Chair Coles asked if the Smith Road bid was the only bid in the envelope, to which Supervisor Curtis said it was. There was a discussion about when the bid actually arrived. Secretary Droppa checked the mailboxes at 6:15 on the night of April 10<sup>th</sup>. Vice Chair Non said he had checked the wrong mailbox and that he checked the U.S. postal mailbox the next morning and it was there. Supervisor Curtis said that the bid did not include the necessary crossovers. Chair Coles made a motion, seconded by Supervisor Curtis to reject all bids and to re-bid both Smith and Ravnika Roads for the may meeting. All voted yes. The motion carried.
