The regularly scheduled meeting of the Clinton Township Planning Commission was held on Thursday , October 7, 2021 at the Clinton Township Municipal Building, Aldenville, Pa.

Rich Martzen called the meeting to order at 7pm.

Modules and Subdivisions:

Ed Harsch had submitted drawings for the Ed and Anna Howell subdivision(#2021-04). With “no detrimental comments” from Wayne County, Rich Martzen made a motion to “Recommend for Final Approval”. Joe Franceski seconded.

Surveyor Harsch then presented new drawings for the Thomas and Janet Seana subdivision.(#2021-05). After reviewing drawings, Brandon Cole made a motion to accept the drawings and forward them to Wayne County Dept. of Planning. Dave Hauenstein seconded the motion.

After recusing himself from voting, planning commission member Matt Tomazic presented drawings for the Debareh E. Hiller subdivision (#2021-06). Creating two new parcels. After review all information, Joe Franceski made a motion to accept the drawings and forward them to Wayne County. Brandon Cole seconded.

It is noted that Matt Tomazic would deliver both the Seana and Hiller packages to Wayne County Planning.


Other Business:


Adjournment:
